Catholic Bishops.

*"This year, the month of November, in which we traditionally remember the dead and pray for the bereaved, will be particularly poignant. We sense a huge yearning for consolation and hope in the heart of our people. We are especially mindful in 2020 of those grieving families, who, because of restrictions, have been unable to experience the customary spiritual and community supports which are so much part of our Irish tradition. On November 1 at 3.00pm the bishops, and priests of Ireland will lead a short service of prayer to dedicate the month of November to "Remembrance of the Dead and Prayer for the Bereaved."*

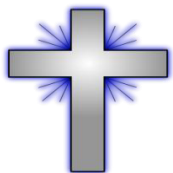
