All ceremonies will still be available to view live online.

Sunday 11 July

Centenary of the Signing of the Truce which brought an end to the War of Independence. The Feast of Blessed Oliver was celebrated on that day in 1921, just one year after his beatification. It was the first day on which the Mass of Blessed Oliver was authorised for use and also the first day that the Divine Office of Blessed Oliver was prayed. Cardinal Tomás Ó Fiaich wrote: "It is worthy of note that the Truce, which brought to an end the War of Independence, came into force on the Feast of Blessed Oliver in 1921." 11.00am Sunday Mass in St Peter's Church celebrated by Bishop Michael Router.

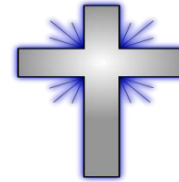
