Saturday 18 & Sunday 26**

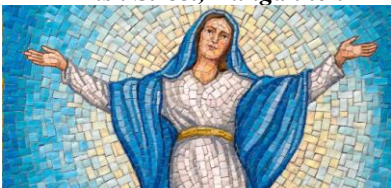
September and Sunday 3 October,
