CHRISTMAS MASSES 2021

Once again this year you will need a pass to get into any of the Christmas Eve or Christmas Day Masses in St Patrick's Church. The times of Masses are detailed inside this bulletin.

Passes will be issued on - **Monday 13 December** from 10.30am to 1.00pm, 2.00pm to 4.00pm, and 6.00pm to 7.00pm from inside St Patrick's Church. Any remaining passes will be available from the Parish Office on Tuesday 14 December from 10.00am – 2.00pm.

Preference will be given to parishioners of Dungannon, Edendork, Clonmore & Killyman, when distributing passes.

Each person wishing to attend Mass will require a pass – a booking form is available inside this bulletin and more are available at the back of St Patrick's Church. In order to ensure that the issuing of passes goes as quickly and smoothly as possible, please have these completed with your details, including the Mass you wish to attend – *if your first choice is not available please be prepared to accept an alternative Mass time.*

Please remember that if you are shielding or vulnerable and have been watching Mass online, you should continue to do so.

We ask that everyone attending Mass wears a face mask whilst in the Church, in order to protect each other.

Please be aware of the importance of hand sanitising when entering the Church and please respect social distancing at all times.
