A nine week novena in honour of St Patrick will take place on Wednesday evenings in the coming weeks, to pray for the renewal of faith in Ireland at this time. The Novena began on Wednesday 19 January at 7pm in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh with Adoration and Rosary and Mass which was celebrated by Archbishop Eamon Martin. Following Armagh, the Novena will take place every Wednesday in different Churches in Ireland associated with St Patrick. 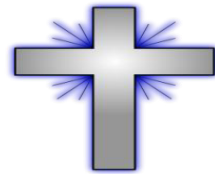
BAPTISMS
