EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Which begins in the parish again on Wednesday 9 February.

While visiting Christ in the Eucharist, there are a variety of options when it comes to prayer and meditation. Here are a few suggestions:

- Be patient with yourself: take time to relax and prepare yourself. There is a story about Saint John Vianney when asked what did he do during adoration, He replied, "I just look at Him and He looks at me."
- Adore Him: This is what we call Eucharistic Adoration. We adore God when we worship Him in His Real Presence in the Eucharist. You can focus on the rosary, the Passion of Christ, on a piece of scripture or personal intercessions. But whatever way you pray, Adoration is an incredible time to be in the presence of God.
- Practise Silence: Cardinal Sarah wrote: "There is no place on earth where God is more present than in the human heart . . . This heart is God's abode, the temple of silence . . . The Father waits for his children in their own hearts."
- Come into His presence with Thanksgiving: Translated from the Greek, the word Eucharist means thanksgiving. The root word of eucharistea is charis, meaning charity "love", as well as "grace". Jesus took the bread and saw it as grace and gave thanks. He took the wine and knew it to be gift and gave thanks. What better time to give thanks to the Lord for what He has done in our lives. You can thank Him for the big and little things of life.

"Jesus awaits us in the sacrament of love. Let us not refuse the time to go to meet him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith, and open to making amends for the serious offences and crimes of the world. Let our adoration never cease."

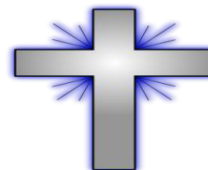
