HEADSTONES & GRAVE SURROUNDS

It has come to our attention that some headstone suppliers have been putting far too much concrete over graves. This is often because they buy the concrete in bulk and they avoid the trouble of taking away the surplus amount by just putting it on the grave. The problem with this is that when the grave needs to be opened again it is very likely that the headstone and/or the surround will be damaged.

Please ensure that you direct your headstone supplier to put only a thin layer of concrete on the grave, or maybe no concrete at all.

We can accept no responsibility if, when re-opening a grave, any damage is caused to either surrounds or headstones if there is a deep layer of concrete.

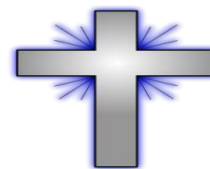
