Archdiocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes
2022 will be taking place this year
from **26 September to 1 October**.

The Pilgrimage will be operating
through Marian Pilgrimages.

The fare is:

* €750 per person sharing (Single
Room Supplement €190)

* Euro720 youth fare

The ongoing impact and
uncertainty around the Covid-19
Pandemic means that this will be a
different Pilgrimage. We will not be
in a position to provide Medical and
Nursing Support in the Accueil
Notre Dame to Assisted Pilgrims as
in prior years. Those Pilgrims
intending to travel will need to be
able to travel independently or to be
accompanied by a family
member/carer who can provide all
of their care and support needs.

All applicants will be required to
complete a comprehensive booking
form, which will include Medical
information. Our Chief Medical
Officer and his team will review this
form prior to acceptance to travel.
All applicants will need to provide
proof of vaccination. While in
Lourdes the Medical Team will be
on call to serve the wider needs of
our pilgrimage community and to
oversee the implementation of our
Covid Protocols, should the need
arise.
